1. Data Controller

3. Data Collection Method

Your personal data is collected voluntarily through survey forms available on the website. The information is filled in directly by you and stored in a secure manner.

4. Purpose of Processing

The collected data is used exclusively for statistical analysis purposes, in the context of the AVTiA Project's goals and activities.

The results are used in an anonymized form for internal reports and project evaluation.

5. Data Sharing and Third Parties

We do not share your personal data with third parties for commercial or marketing purposes.

However, we may use aggregated and anonymized metadata for statistical reporting within

the project framework.

No personal identification will be disclosed in these cases.

6. Data Retention

Your personal data will be retained only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose stated above and in accordance with applicable project and legal requirements.

After this period, the data will be securely deleted or anonymized.

7. Cookies and Usage Data

Our website may use cookies and similar technologies to ensure proper functioning and improve user experience. These may include:

- Essential cookies (required for website functionality)
- Statistical cookies (to anonymously track website usage)

You can manage or disable cookies through your browser settings.

8. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure, or access.
